

Dear Extended Day Parents and Families,

After careful consideration of The Minimum Requirements for Health and Safety from EEC: https://eeclead.force.com/resource/1592325278000/Min_Req we have decided not to offer a Summer Extended Day Program this year. The requirements are very involved and very restrictive. It will take a great deal of time and planning before we are ready to operate a program under these guidelines, in order to maintain the proper safety in these uncertain times.

It is of utmost importance that when we are ready to reopen, we can do so in the safest way possible for children, staff and families. I feel that this was the best decision under the circumstances, but I also recognize that some of you were still hoping as much as we were!

For many of you, the next thought on your mind is fall. What are the plans for Extended Day in the fall and what will that look like? The short answer is that we just don't know yet. I think before we move forward, we need to know what the school day will look like. The school department will be getting DESE guidance within a week and that will start the ball rolling in earnest. The Superintendent has set up various planning committees, and I hope to be involved in two of them - Operations and CFB.

As I learn information that is clearly set in stone, I will share. In the meantime, I wish you all a summer of health and happiness.
